The entrance exam consists of 3 papers with objective questions on general studies and CSAT based on CSE model and UPSC syllabus, followed by written essay. The entrance test will be conducted in English language only. Entrance test will be for 150 marks.

The entrance exam will have a total of 3 papers:

- Paper 1 - consist of objective type General Studies questions.
- Paper 2 - consist of objective type CSAT questions.

Candidates should note that there will be penalty (Negative Marking) for wrong answers and 0.33 marks will be deducted per wrong answer. There will be no penalty for questions left unanswered.

- Paper 3 - consist of essay writing.

Interview:

Candidates will be shortlisted for the interview based on their performance in the entrance exam. The interview will be conducted either in Bengaluru or online.
